1. [15 points] Circle the best answer.

3. [15 points] Circle the best answer.

If acceleration $\vec{a}(t)$ is always a scalar multiple of position $\vec{r}(t)$, then...

- (b) $\vec{r}(t) \cdot \vec{v}(t)$ is constant.

4. [25 points] Suppose that you are driving, your speed is currently 15m/s, your speed is increasing at a rate of 2m/s^2 , and the radius of curvature of the road is currently 70m. Calculate the magnitude of your current acceleration vector. Give a numerical answer accurate up to an error of 0.1m/s^2 .

5. [30 points] Find the curvature $\kappa(t)$ of $\vec{r}(t) = \langle t, 3 \cos t, 3 \sin t \rangle$; **show your work.**
